The Fresh Pond Parkway side of the lot has 0 residential abutters, while Alpine Street is 100% residential. Focusing the development and bus traffic on Alpine is a bad idea for abutters.

D) Developing the best transportation system to all schools as well as within the neighborhood.

A smaller footprint, even if taller, placed nearest the corner by [Fresh Pond Parkway](#) and Vassal Lane will preserve as much of the playgrounds and fields as possible, it also can mean less hazardous waste disturbed, and will affect abutters, including those on Vassal, the least. Please also limit car traffic as much as possible – viz, please do not add an access road behind Alpine St., and do not create more drop-off and pick-up spots without...
