# **MBTA Updates**

#### **MBTA Green Line Extension**

- MBTA announced the opening of the first branch of the Green Line Extension to be Monday, March 21, 2022
  - A grand opening event is scheduled for the morning and service is planned to start in the afternoon
  - Events at both Union and Lechmere stations
  - Route 69, 80, 87, 88 buses will move to new Lechmere
  - Green Line-replacement shuttles will operate until service begins
- Service to Medford/Tufts is planned to open in Spring 2022
- GLX/MBTA have not announced a timeline for opening the Community Path Extension to North Point

#### **MBTA Service Restorations**

- A schedule change took effect on Sunday, December 19, 2021
- The next schedule change is planned for Sunday, March 13, 2022
- Service changes can be found on MBTA's website:
  - Route 71 and 73 will have diesel-hybrid buses. This means that passengers will board and alight at Harvard Upper Busway. Passengers will now pay when boarding.
  - Route 77A will also be suspended
  - Routes 69, 80, 87, and 88 will move to new Lechmere station when that station opens on March 22
  - Minor schedule changes for Routes 1, 47, 66, 68, 96, 350


