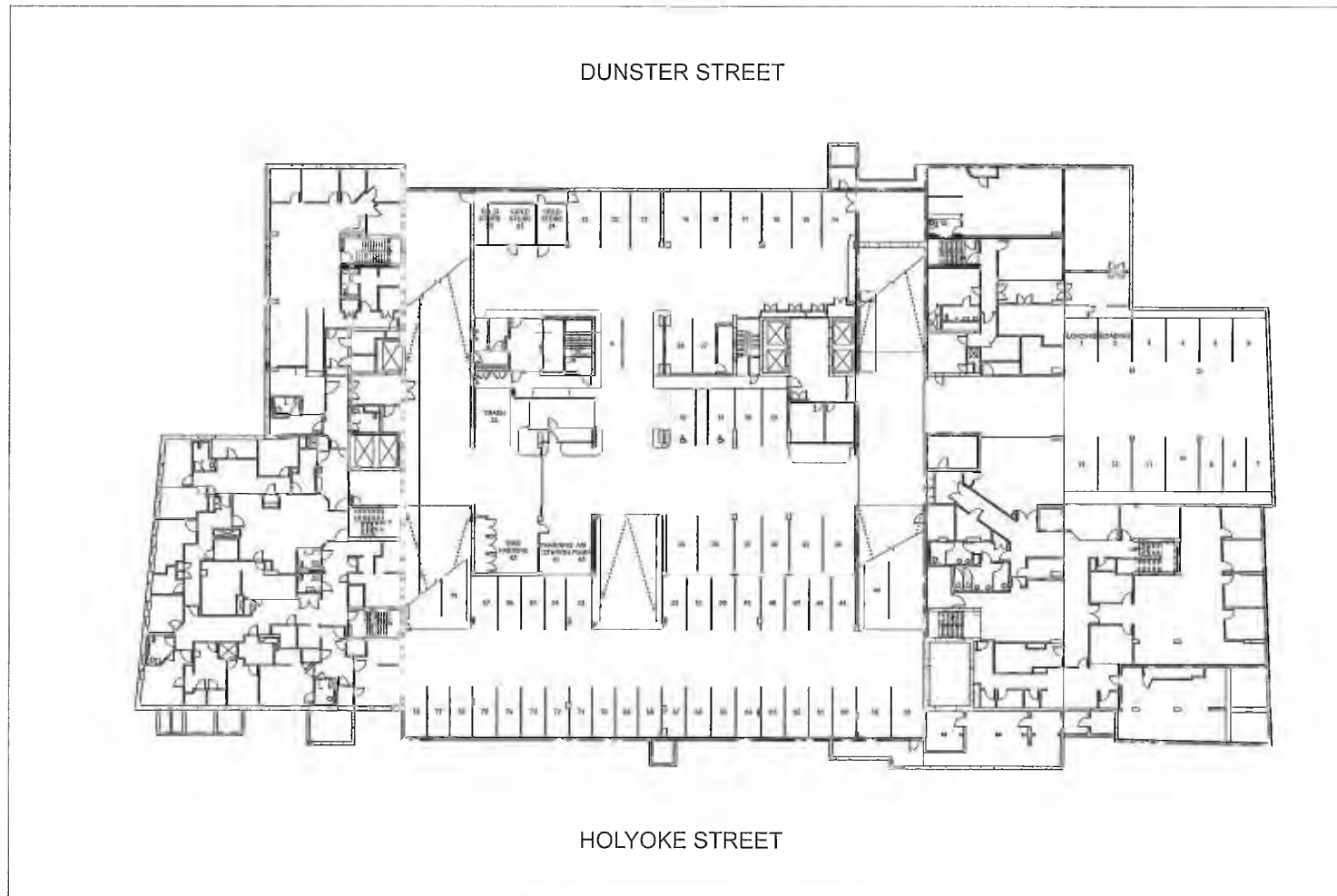
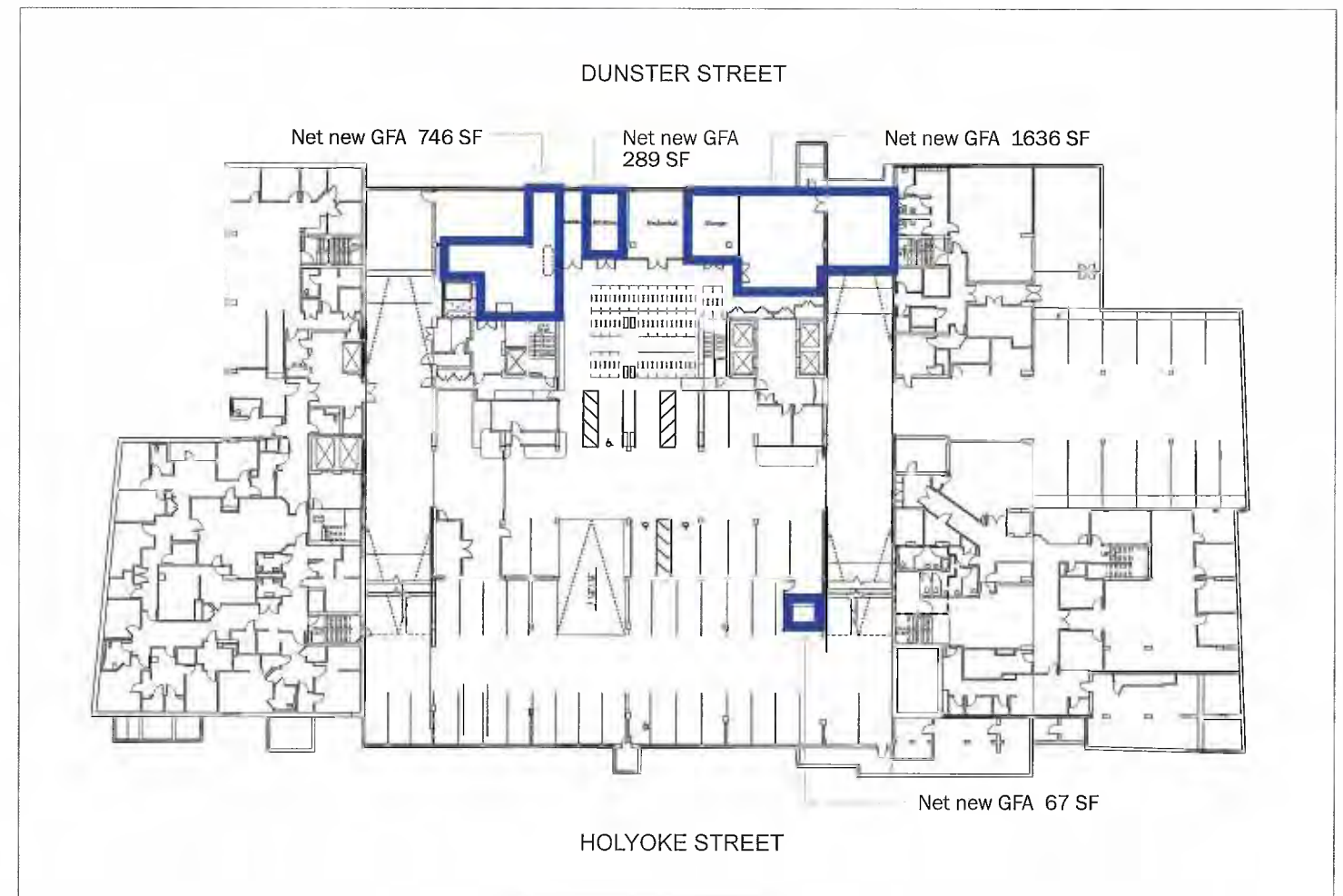

EXISTING BASEMENT



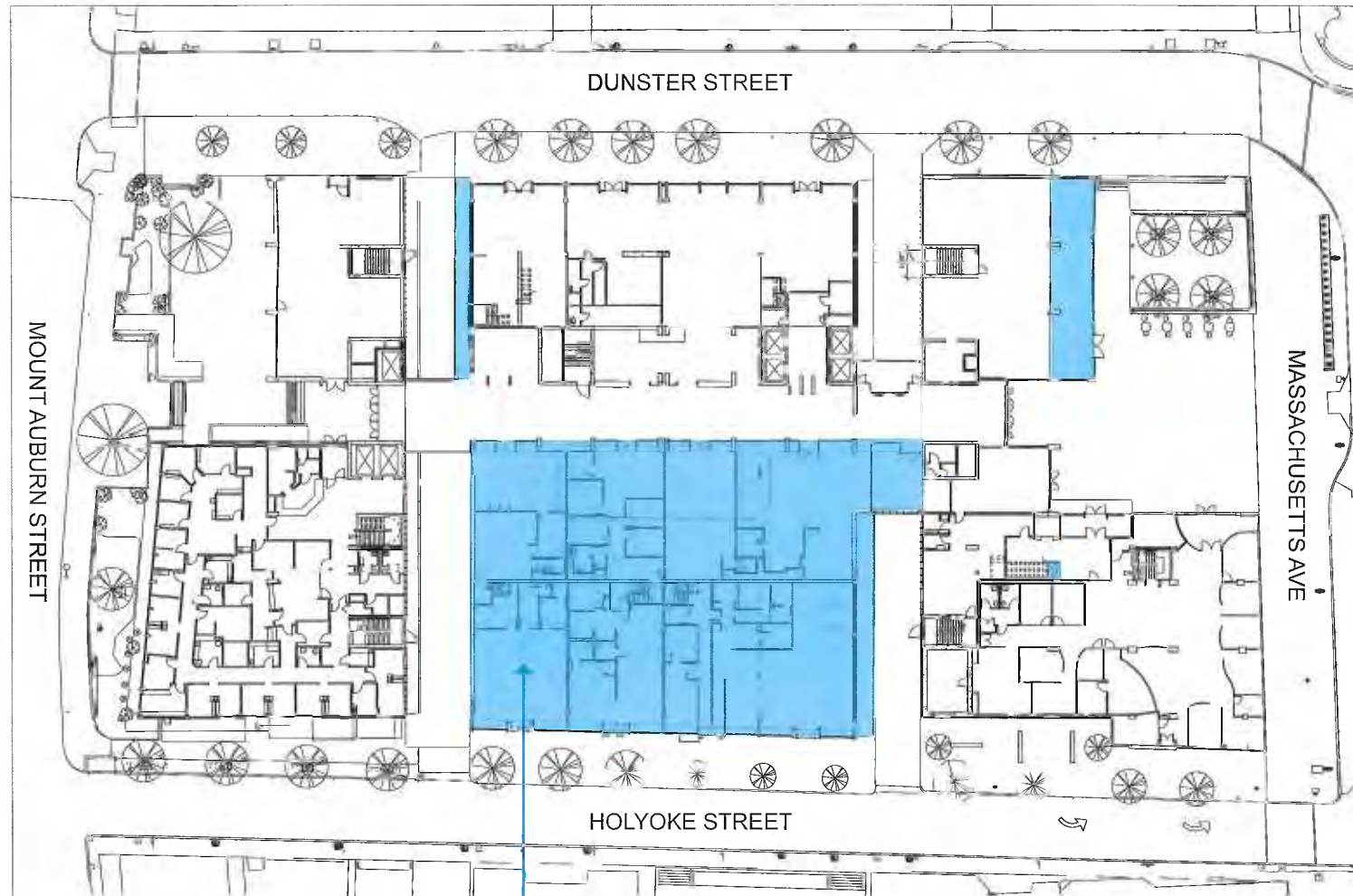

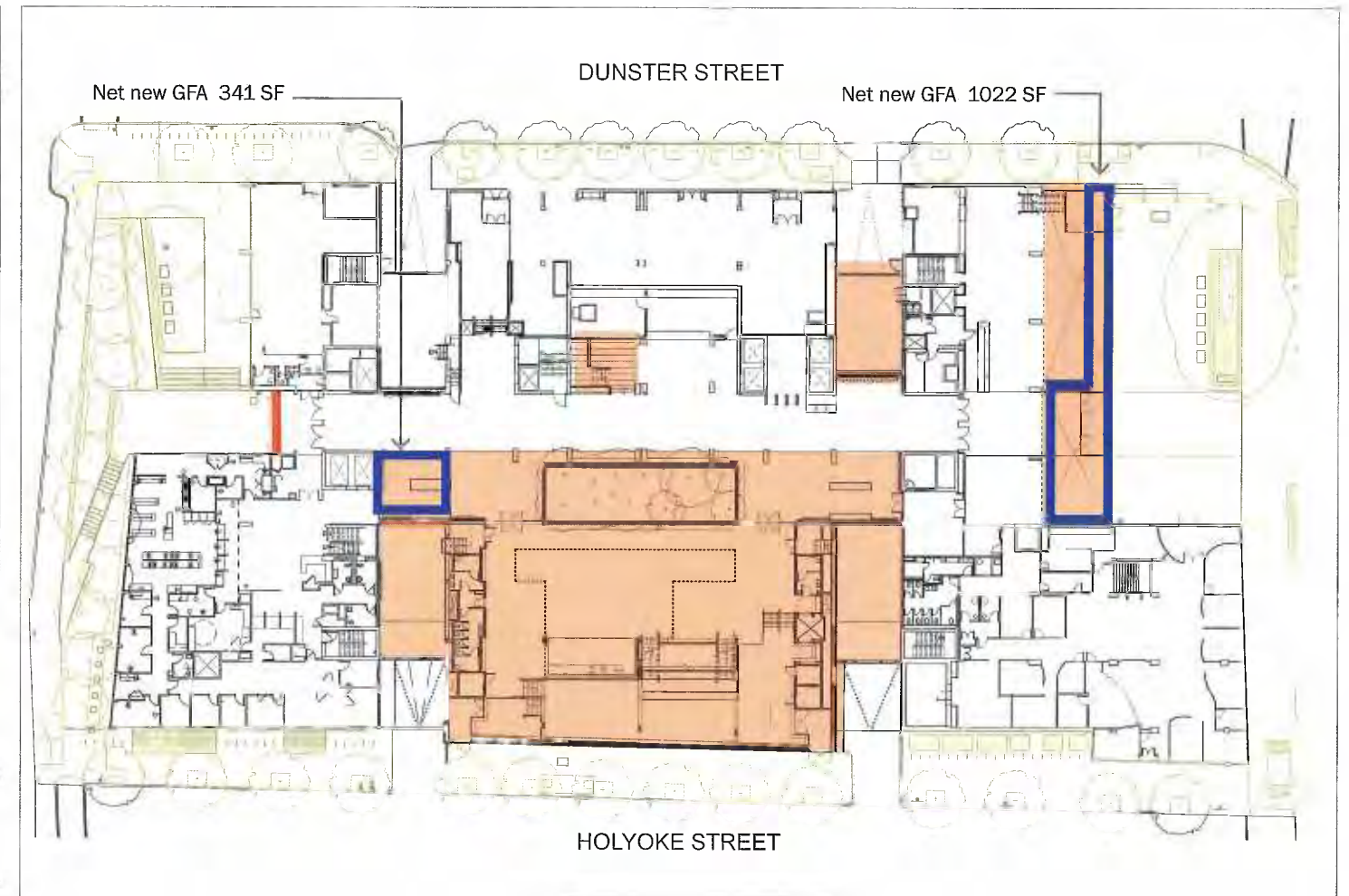

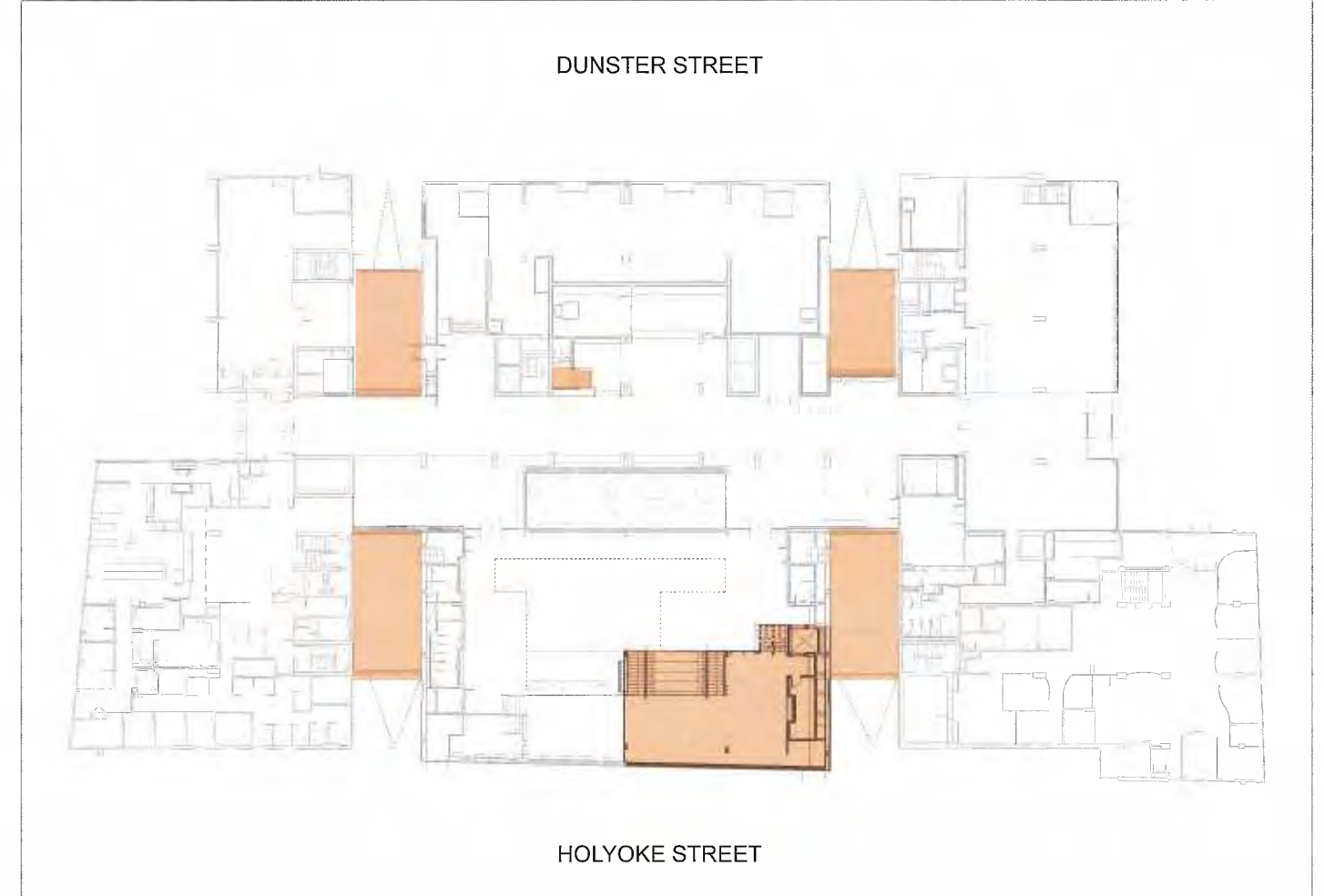

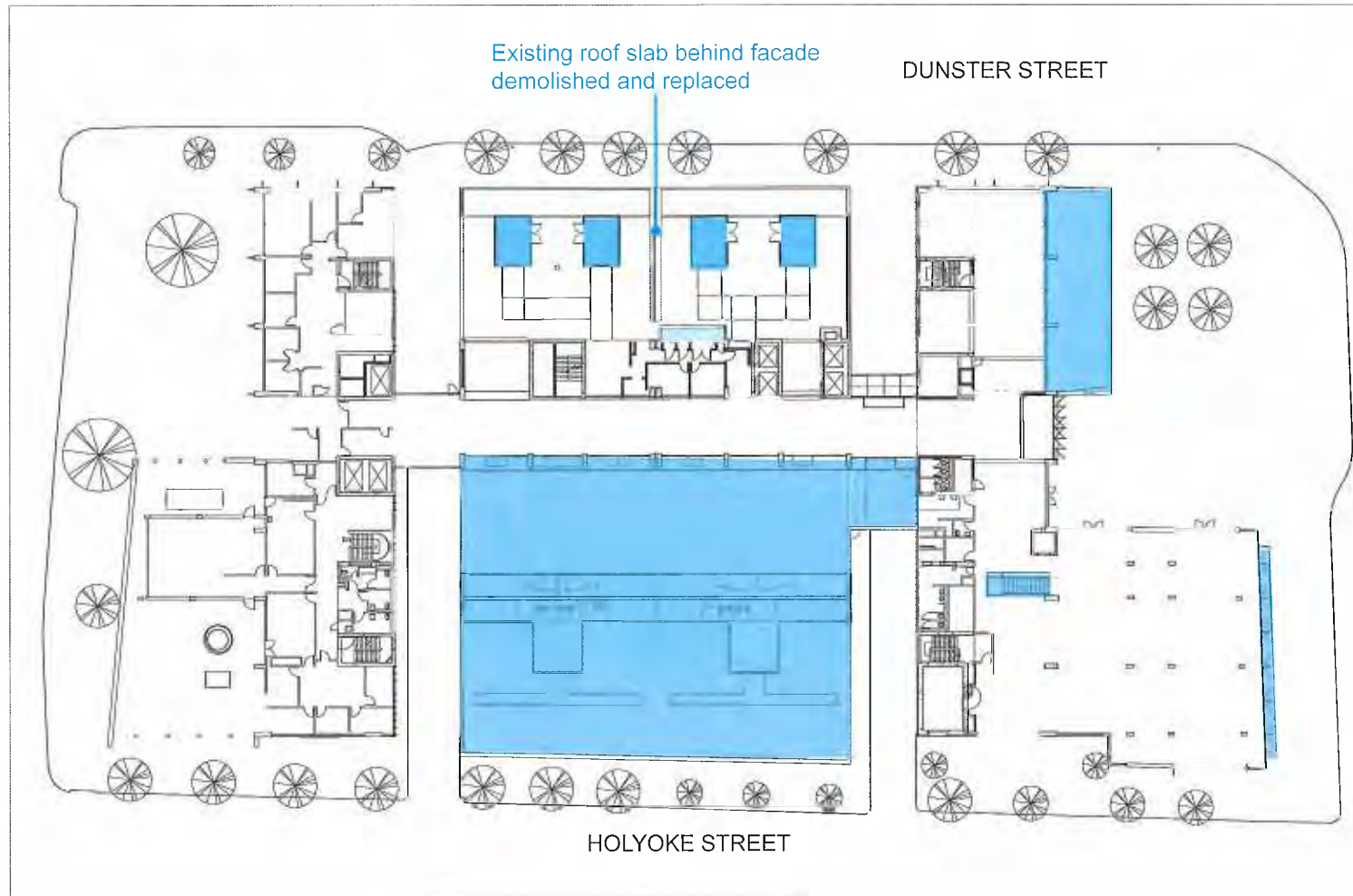

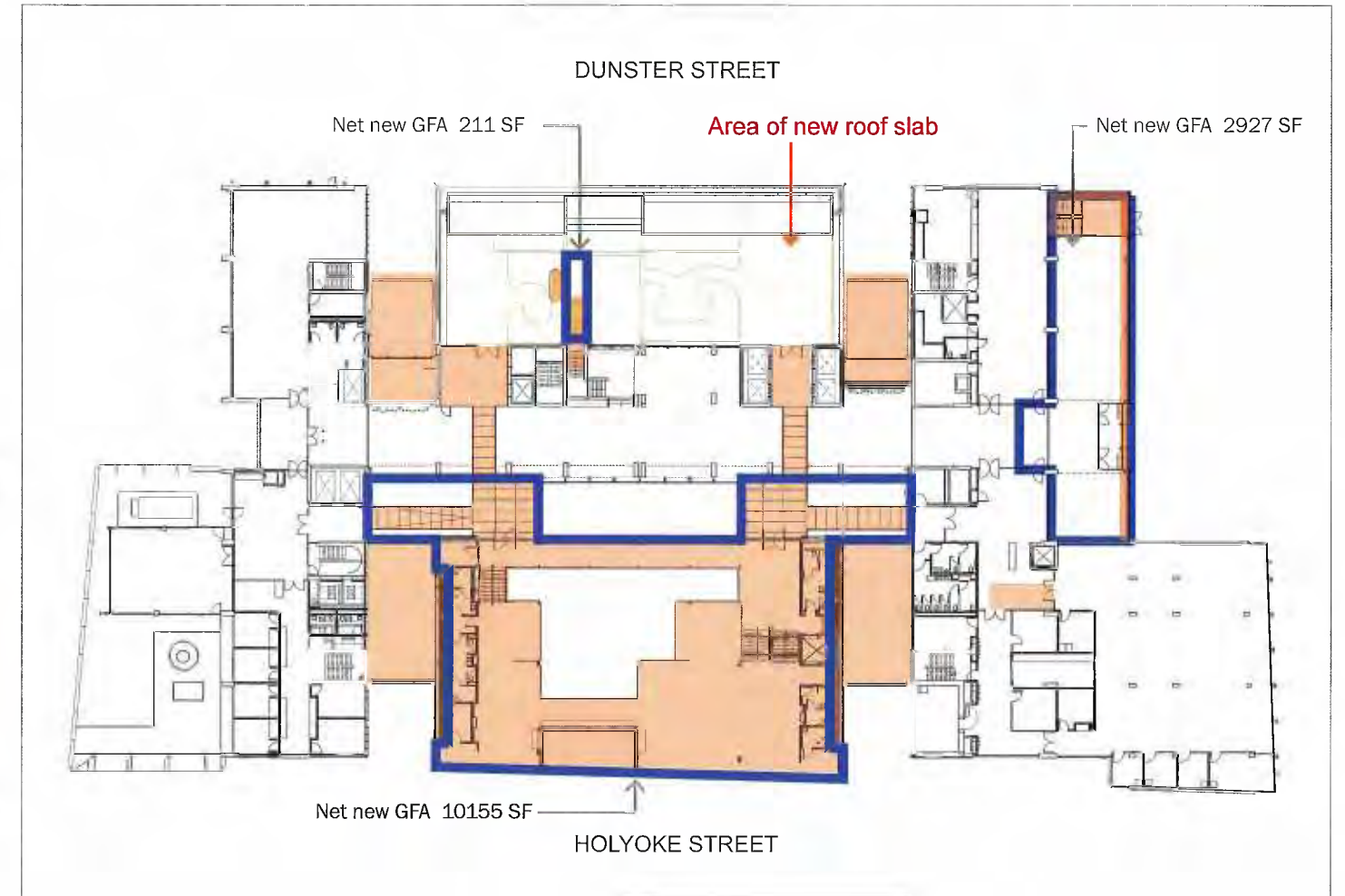

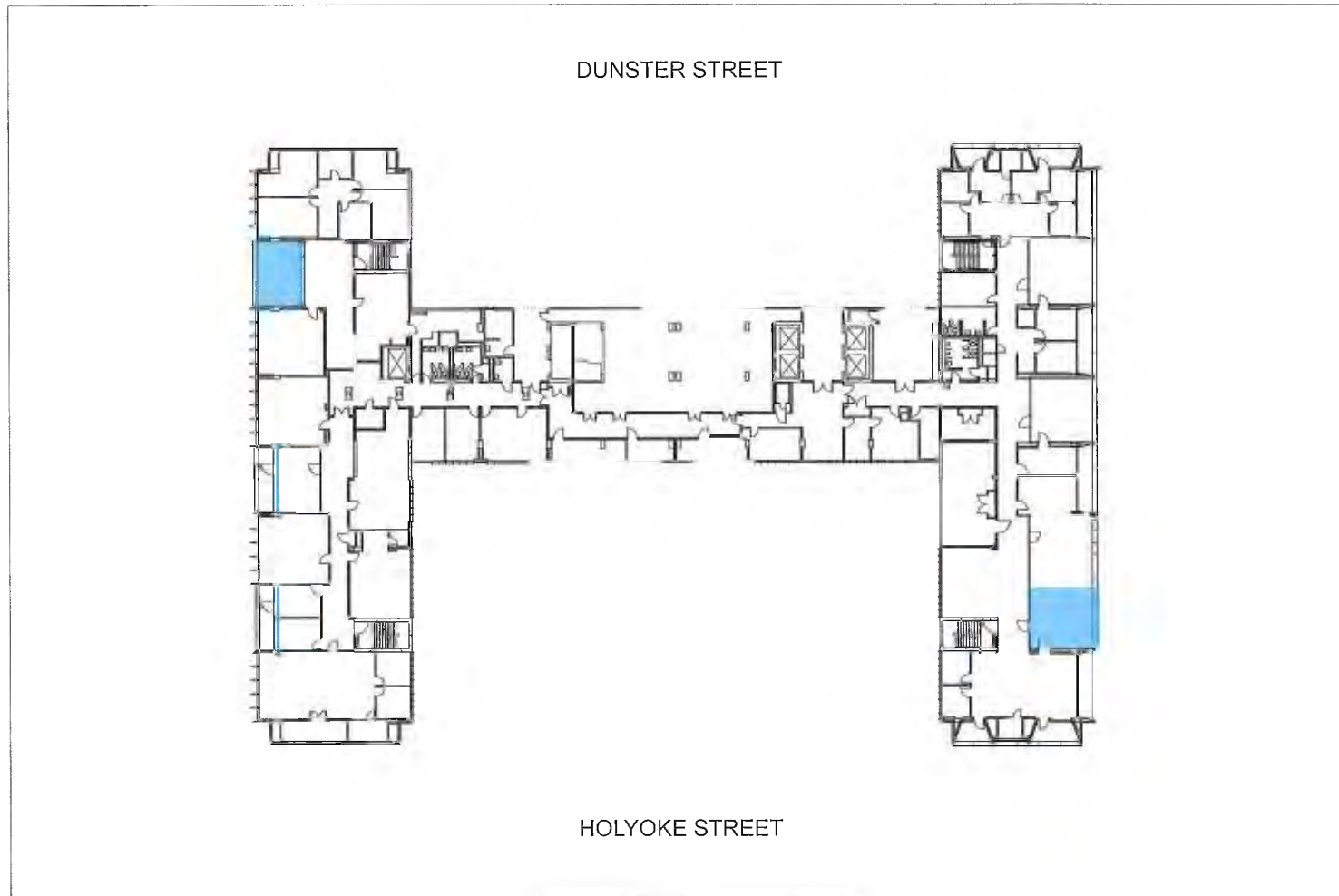

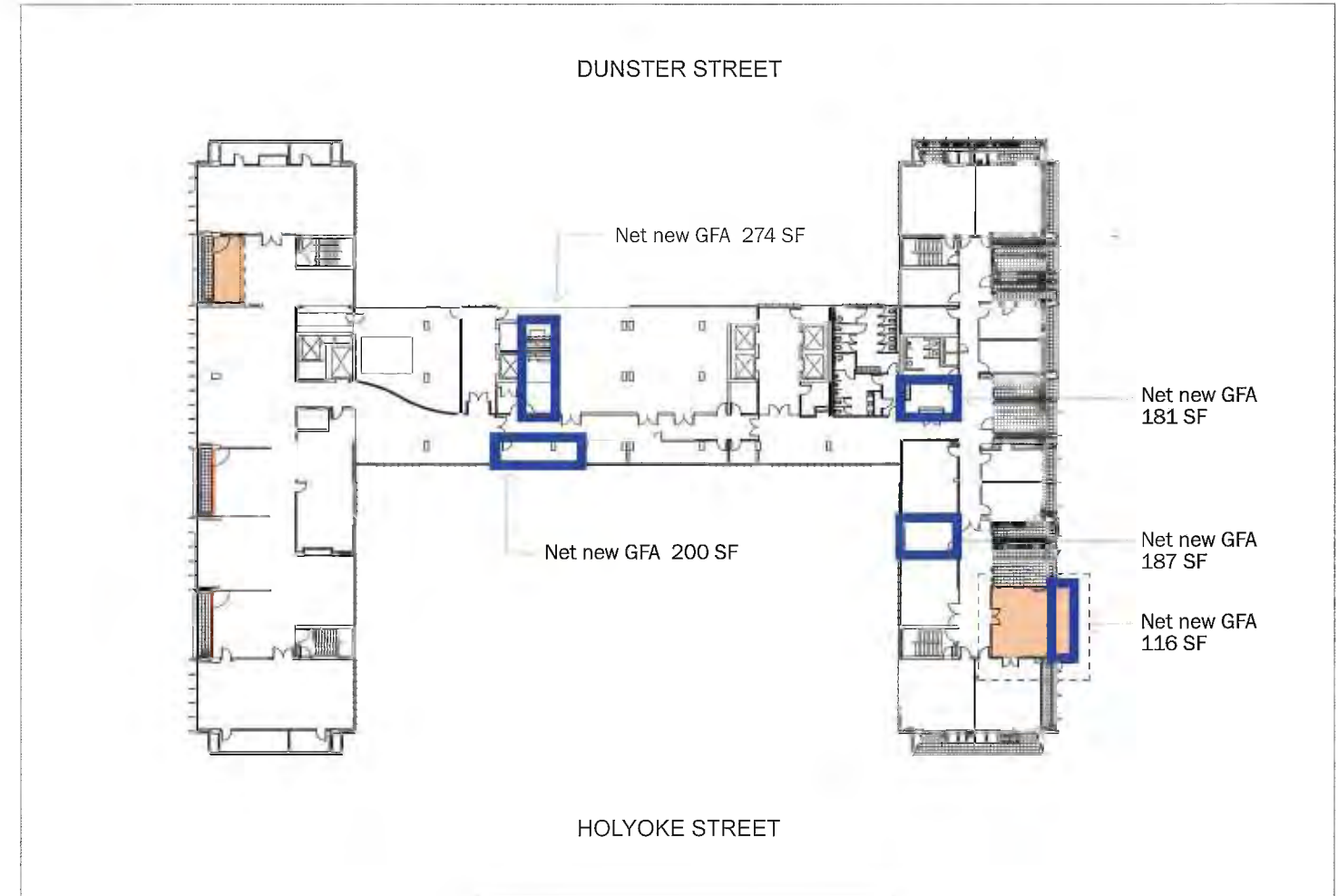

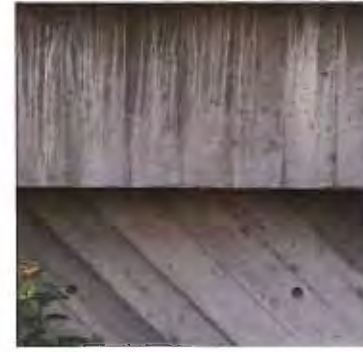

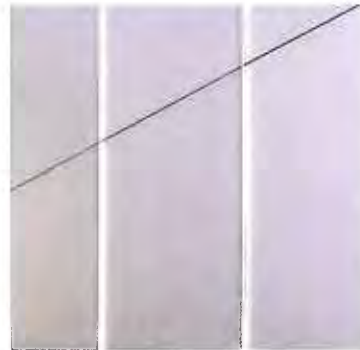

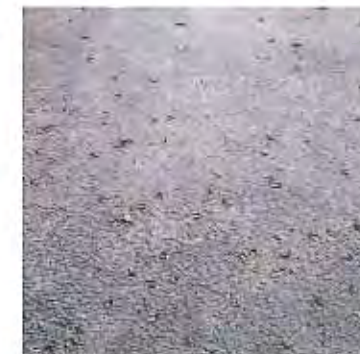

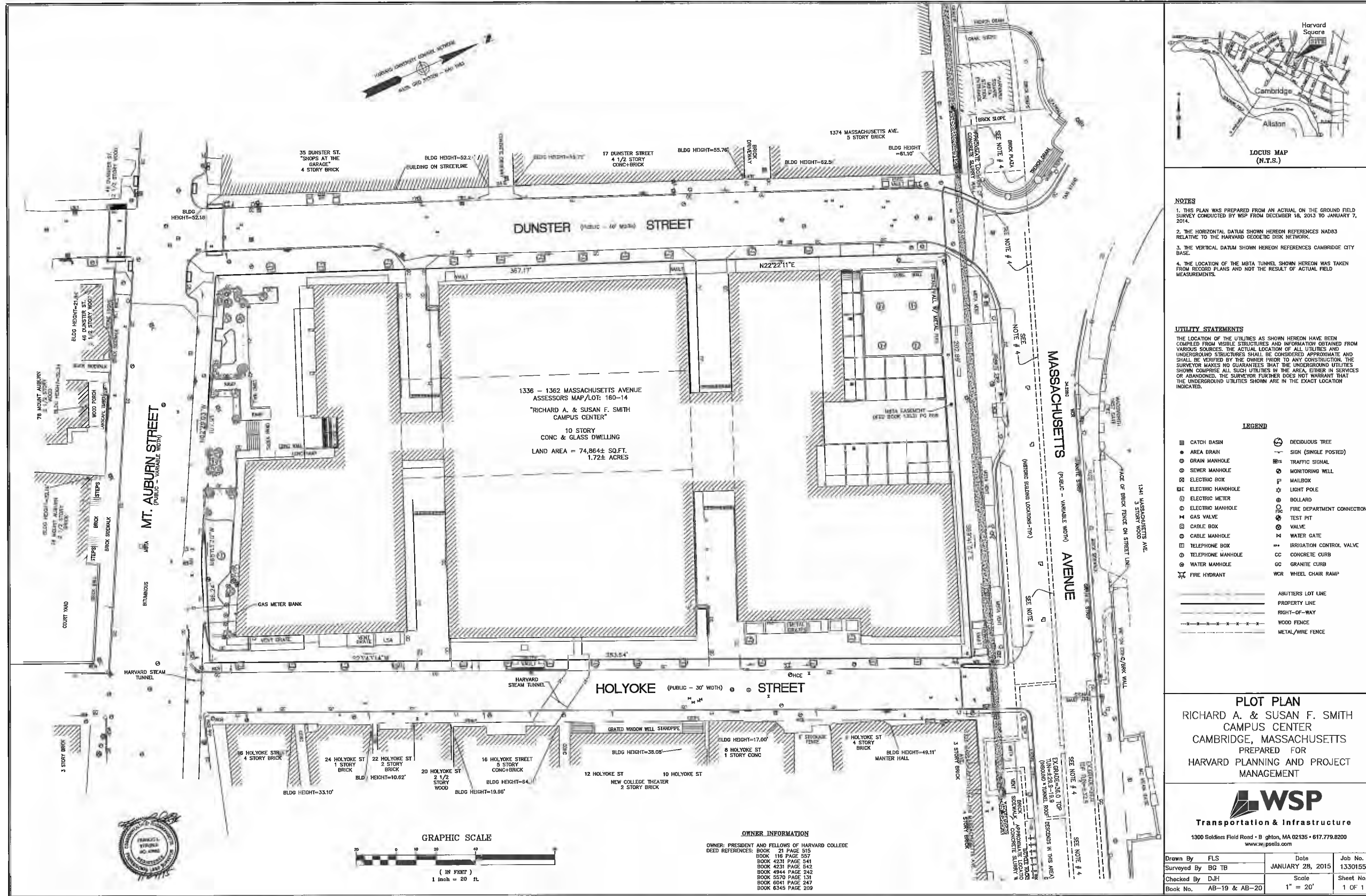
