Advance Processing of Ballots – Ms. Ford sent out an email to commissioners asking for advance processing workers who can commit for the whole week. It will take place October 31st to November 4th.

Post processing will start 9:00 am on Tuesday November 15th, at the Senior Center using the high-speed scanner.

The State is providing three options for ballots collected on election day. 1) Send all ballots to the polls. 2) Pick a cut off time on election day. 3) Save all ballots for post processing. The state must be notified by November 4th, regarding which option we will use.


