HURLEY PARK RENOVATION UPDATE

Tree Maintenance Activity Week of October 14

Dear Hurley Park Neighbor,

As you may know, the city is planning a comprehensive renovation of Hurley Park. Next week, DPW Forestry crews will be onsite performing tree maintenance work in preparation for the park renovation. Once the tree work is complete, the city's contractor, JNJ Sacca Inc, will mobilize to begin the park renovation.

Project Details

The renovated park will include:

- Refurbished playground
- Water and sand play area
- Water sprinklers
- Tables and seating with umbrellas
- New community garden (raised beds)
- Improved lighting
- Swing benches
- New art fence
- Reconstructed park pathways and sidewalk on Hurley St
- Emergency phone and message board.

Project Schedule

Crews will mobilize during the week of October 14 to perform tree maintenance work. Once the tree work is complete, Sacca will mobilize to begin the improvements. Please note that all work is weather dependant. Overall construction is expected to take about 9-12 months to complete. We will continue to provide updates as the construction progresses.

What to Expect during Renovations

The park will be closed to all users once crews mobilize next week. No Parking signs will be posted along Hurley St; please be sure to check dates and times. Work hours will be 7 AM to 4 PM, Monday through Friday.
