The Project Area and Design

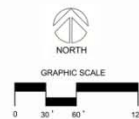
The closure of Kingsley Park from April 1- September 1 will allow for:

KINGSLEY PARK PHASE I IMPROVEMENTS





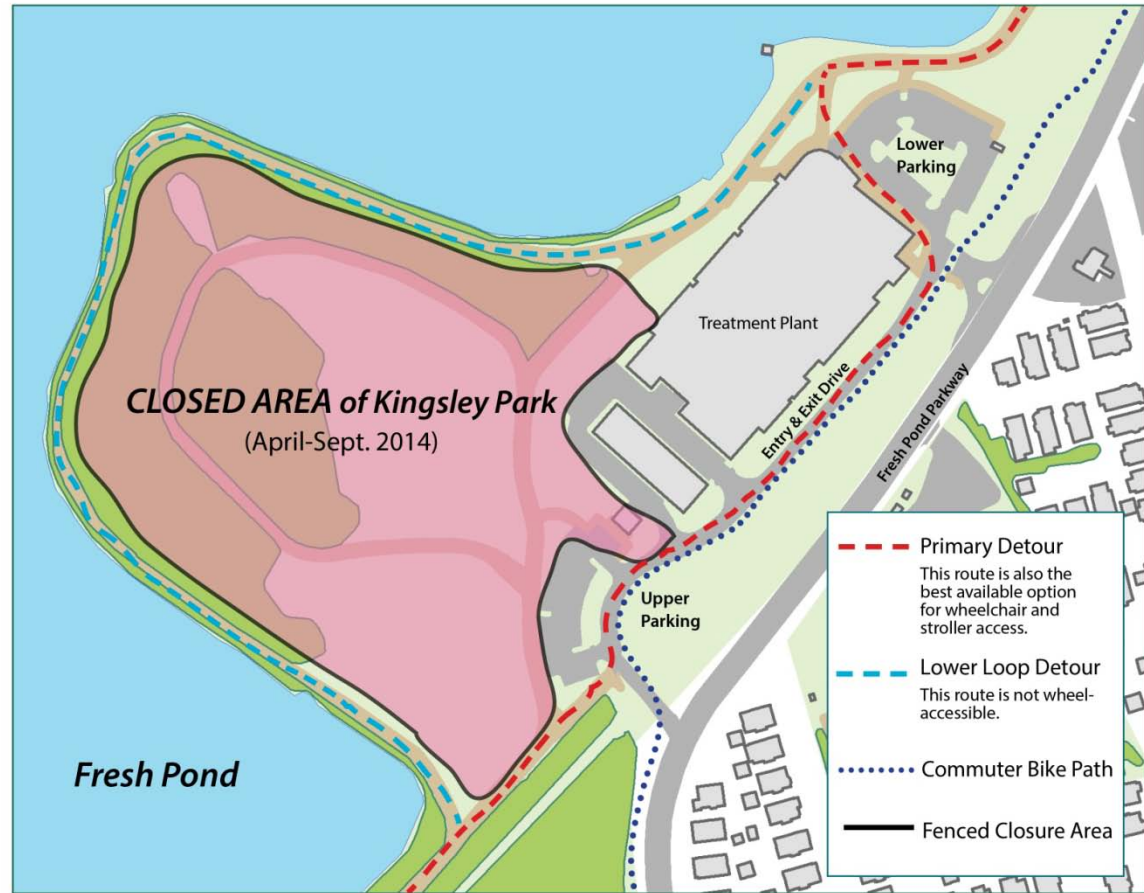
From April 1 – September 1, Kingsley Park will close and be fenced-off.

All of Kingsley Park will be off-limits and fenced. Two routes around it will remain:

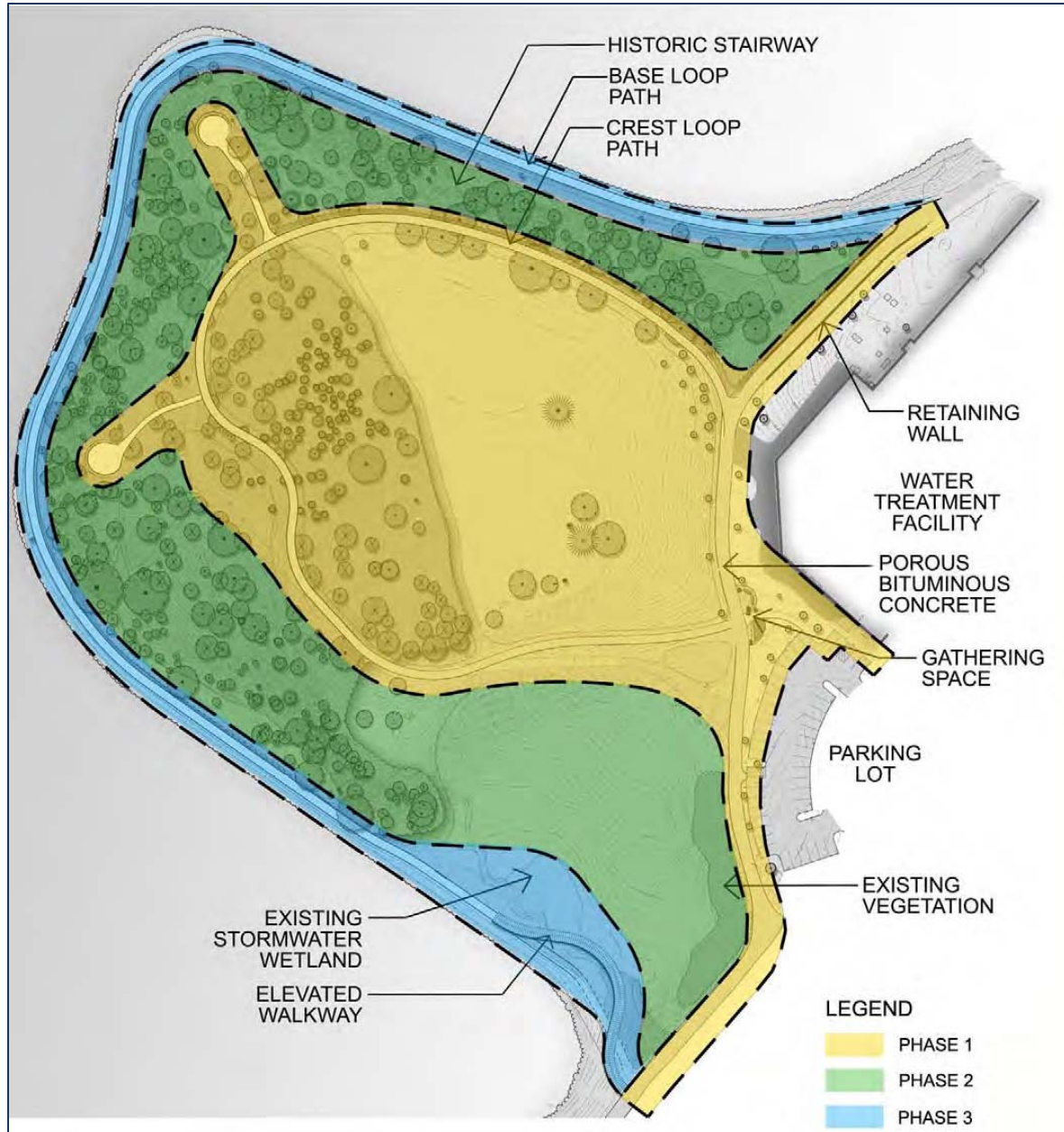
1. Main drive detour
