The Planning Board of the City of Cambridge will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, November 22, 2022, at 6:30 p.m.**, conducted remotely (see below for directions) on a Zoning Petition by the City Council to amend Article 22.000, Section 22.25.1, Paragraph (c) of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Cambridge. The proposed amendment would add to the information required to be included in the Net Zero Narrative for a project that is subject to the Green Building Requirements in Section 22.20.

In addition to the current set of required information, the proposed amendment would require an "Embodied Emissions" section, described as "A full lifecycle analysis of the estimated emissions generated by the construction of the Green Building Project." The proposed amendment would also clarify that information about energy loads, energy targets, energy use intensity (EUI), and greenhouse gas emissions, which are currently required as part of the Net Zero Narrative, would be "calculated in accordance with the standards and requirements established in Chapter 8.67 of the Municipal Code ("Building Energy Use") and associated regulations." The Net Zero Narrative is provided for advisory review.
