for the property located at	87-101 Blanchard Road
for which the developer is	B'nai B'nai Community Development, LLC
pursuant to	Section 11.207 Affordable Housing Overlay
for a proposal to	Construct a senior housing in place of an existing 2-story commercial building to create 110 affordable rental units and amenities, and 87 long-term and 12 short-term bicycle parking spaces with a gross floor area of 103,726 square feet.

The Planning Board will hear a presentation of the proposal from the developer and comments from the public. Comments may be sent in advance in writing or made at the meeting (see instructions below).

The purpose of the advisory design consultation is for the Planning Board to comment on the proposal in relation to Section 11.207 of the Cambridge Zoning Ordinance and the City's development guidelines and objectives. This will be the first of two required advisory design consultation meetings.
