

Parking Changes

Huron A, Huron B, and Concord Ave Neighborhoods

The short-term parking that supports the local businesses is being disrupted by the construction of the Alewife Sewer Separation Project. The Public Works and the Traffic departments have been working to identify alternative parking locations and have recently changed the parking regulations on Fayerweather St and Huron Ave to support customer parking. However, as construction picks up in the spring, this street by street approach is not going to work. It is confusing to customers and can overly burden individual streets.



We want to take a *more comprehensive approach* to providing short-term parking for customers, while maintaining residential parking and spreading the impacts. We will be modifying the parking regulations for the duration of construction. *Existing residential parking areas in the 3 contract areas (see back page for map) will be changed to a combination of residential parking / 2-hour parking.* If you have a resident parking sticker, you can continue to park in these areas. Vehicles without a resident sticker are limited to 2 hours. This change will support both the residential and business needs. Existing disability parking spaces and unrestricted parking will not be modified.
