RE: Huron B Sewer Separation Project

WATER SERVICE SHUTDOWN: Lexington Avenue (Brattle to Huron)

Dear Residents,

The City's contractor, Barletta Heavy Division, is scheduled to do water work at the intersection of Lexington and Huron Avenue, weather permitting, **on Tuesday, April 12th, beginning at 9 AM** (contingency date is Wednesday, April 13th). There will be a temporary water service shutdown on Lexington Avenue to facilitate this work, as part of the City's Alewife Sewer Separation Project – Huron B. During this time, you will have <u>no water</u> service to your property. We are anticipating this shutdown will last from 9 AM to 5 PM however, we will make every effort to expedite this work to minimize the length of time the water will be shut down. Please take appropriate steps to store water for your anticipated needs during this time.

We ask you to pay attention to the "**NO PARKING**" signs, which will be posted 24-hours in advance of this work.

Please note that after the water is restored you may notice some discoloration of your water. We recommend you run your cold water or outside spigots until it is clear before any use, including laundry.
