

Huron Ave (Reservoir to Concord) ROADWAY RECONSRUCTION Beginning Week of September 12th, 2016

Dear Residents/ Business Owners,

Starting **the week of September 12**th (weather permitting), the City's contractor, Barletta Heavy Division, will be starting the first phase of **roadway reconstruction** of **Huron Avenue** (Concord Ave. to Reservoir St.). During this time, <u>traffic and parking impacts along</u> <u>Huron Avenue will occur</u>. Roadway reconstruction includes full-depth roadway demolition, sublayer fine grading, and base course paving. <u>Work will begin on the south side lane</u> of Huron Avenue, with two-way traffic being maintained on the north side lane. Final paving will occur at a later date, for which you will receive a separate notification. Construction hours are 7am to 4 pm. <u>This phase of the work is anticipated to take 4 weeks to</u> <u>complete</u>. The contractor will then mobilize to work on another area on Huron Avenue. Impacts outlined below will be similar for all phases of Huron Ave reconstruction, which will extend into next year.

What to Expect During Roadway Reconstruction:

- There will be **No Parking allowed on the street, in designated areas, 24/7.** This will maintain two-way traffic and also **minimize dust levels,** by limiting vehicle travel on unpaved surfaces, in the work zone areas during construction. Please pay attention to all posted signs.
 - **NOTE :** *2HR/RES* established parking will be available for residents and customers during this work (until project completion) on contract area side streets.
- Vehicle traffic will be maintained during this work on Huron Avenue. Signage and police details will be onsite to assist with temporary traffic pattern modifications and pedestrian safety. (*see MAP on back of flyer*)
- **Side street detours** will be in effect in those areas adjacent to the roadway work from 7am to 4pm. Be aware of posted "road closed" and "detour" signs.
- **Driveway or entryway access** for homes directly in front of this roadway work may be temporarily impacted. The contractor will coordinate access directly with residents.
- **Emergency vehicle access** to all properties will be maintained during this time.
- **City services** will continue uninterrupted.
