Harvard University and the COOP are planning a substantial renovation of 12-30 Palmer Street. The proposed scope of work preserves the existing clinker brick and limestone façade, while introducing new punched windows, glass bay windows, and an illuminated three-story tall metal trellis lantern feature at the new building entrance. The project includes a complete renovation of the building interior, new mechanical systems, and a green roof. A new concourse on the ground floor will provide a public area at the same level as the retail and main office entrance, to support the retail uses and to provide full accessibility. The design at the street level calls for a stepped terrace, benches, and planters to be an extension of the concourse for the public. Harvard University is partnering with the Harvard Cooperative Society ("COOP") to renovate and re-imagine 12-30 Palmer Street to bring new life to this part of Harvard Square. Enclosed please find a completed application for a Certificate of Appropriateness for this proposed project.

The former Harvard COOP Book Store Annex building, designed by Samuel Glaser Associates, was purpose built in 1964 as an annex to support The COOP's retail and product storage needs. Now vacant, the proposed project contemplates a reinvigorated mixed-use building with an active and vibrant street presence. The proposed scope of work preserves the existing clinker brick and limestone façade, while introducing new punched windows, glass bay windows, and an illuminated three-story tall metal trellis lantern feature at the new building entrance. A new concourse on the ground floor will provide a public area at the same level as the retail and main office entrance, to support the retail uses and to provide full accessibility. The design at the street level calls for a stepped terrace, benches, and planters to be an extension of the concourse for the public.
