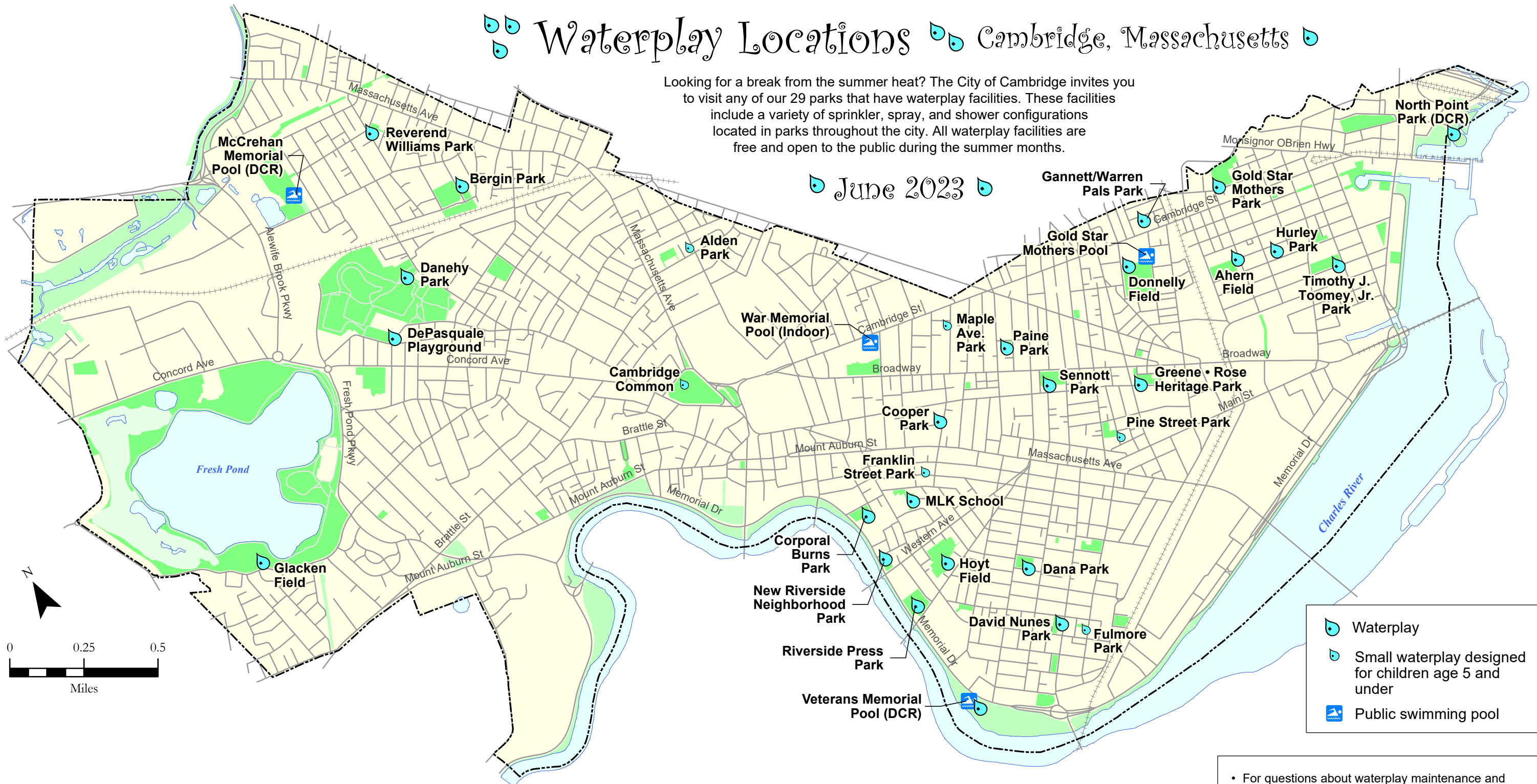


Waterplay Locations Cambridge, Massachusetts
