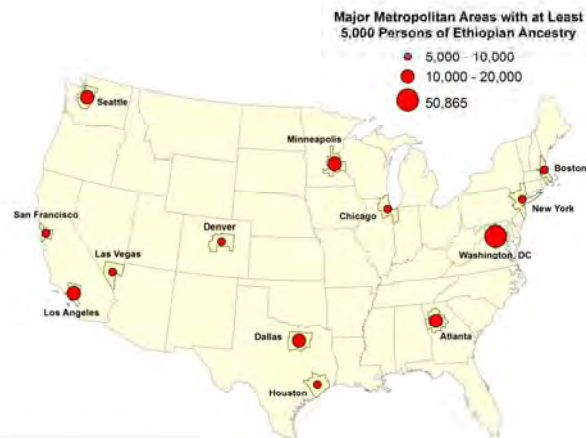

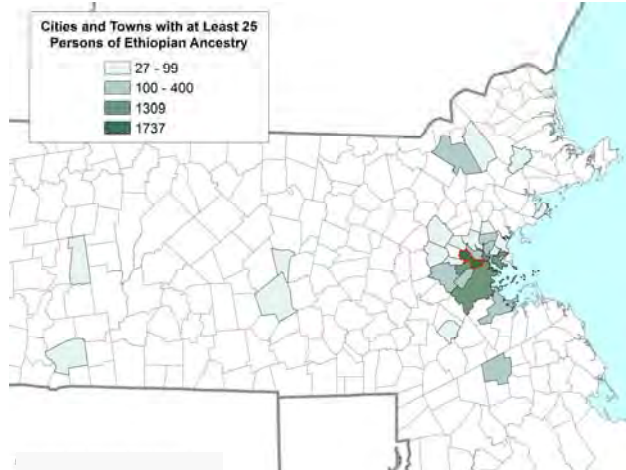
## Where Do Persons of Ethiopian Descent Live in the United States?

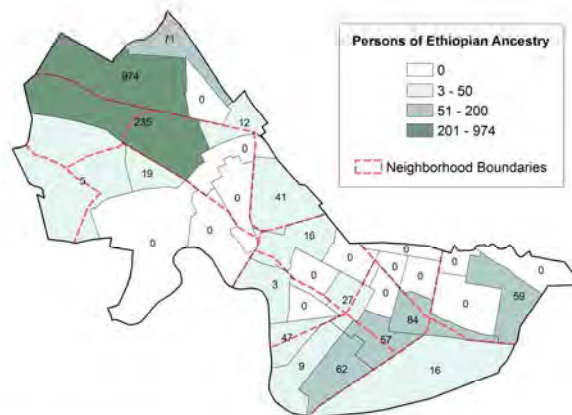
## Where Do Persons of Ethiopian Descent Live in Massachusetts?

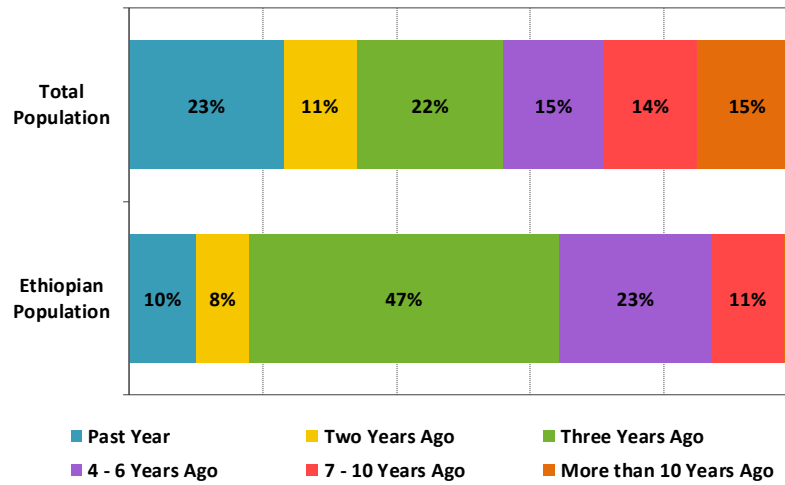
## Where Do Persons of Ethiopian Descent Live in Cambridge?

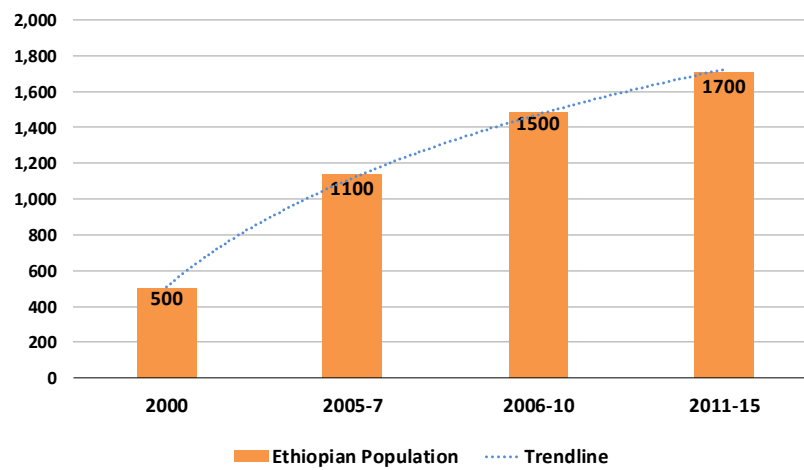
## Household Stability & Transience: 2011 - 2015

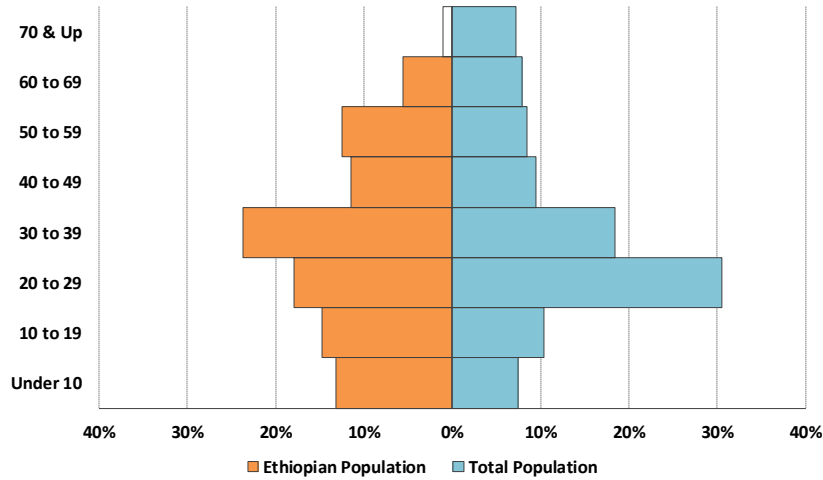
## Population Trend: 2000 - 2015

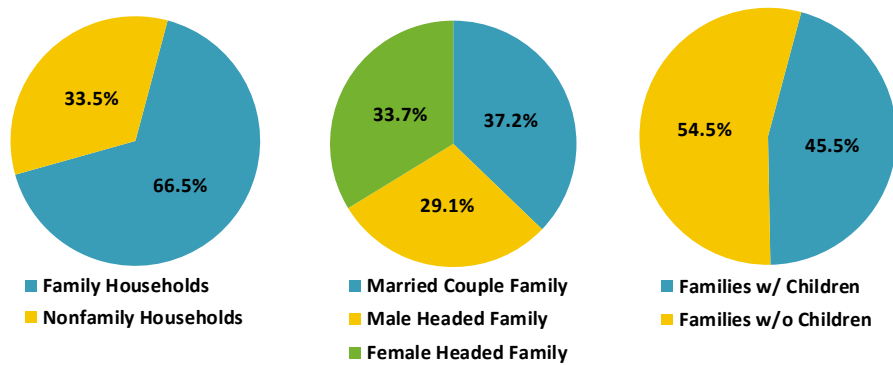
## Age Distribution of Population: 2011 - 2015

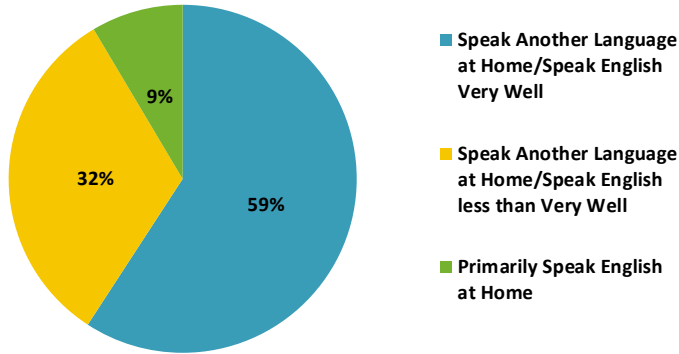

## Language Spoken at Home & Ability to Speak English

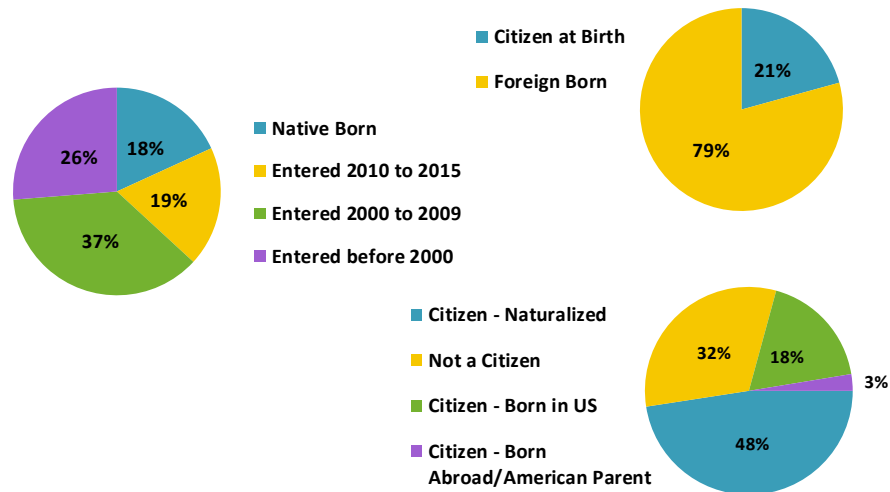
Population 5 and Older

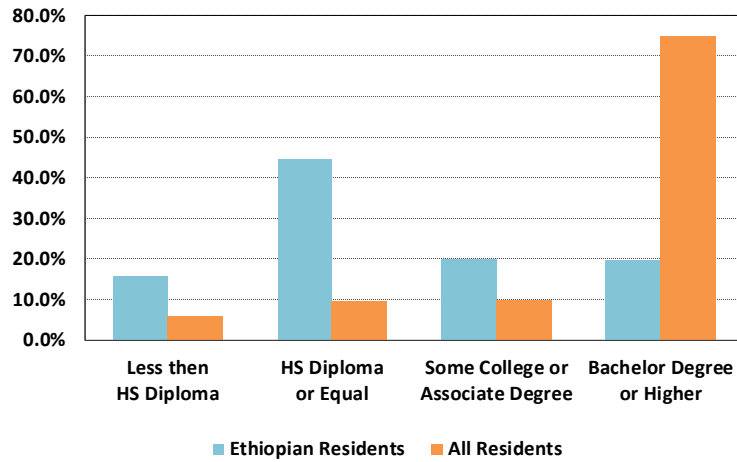
## Place of Birth, Year of Entry & Citizenship: 2011 - 2015

### Population 25 & Older

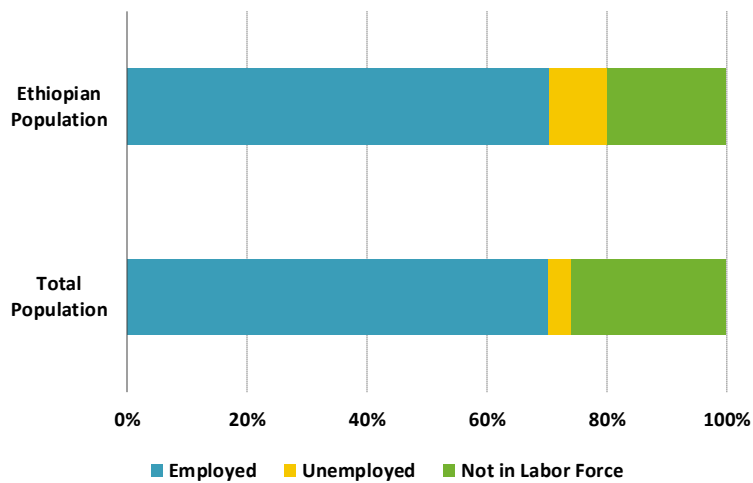

- Health Care Support (e. g., medical assistant, nursing home aide)

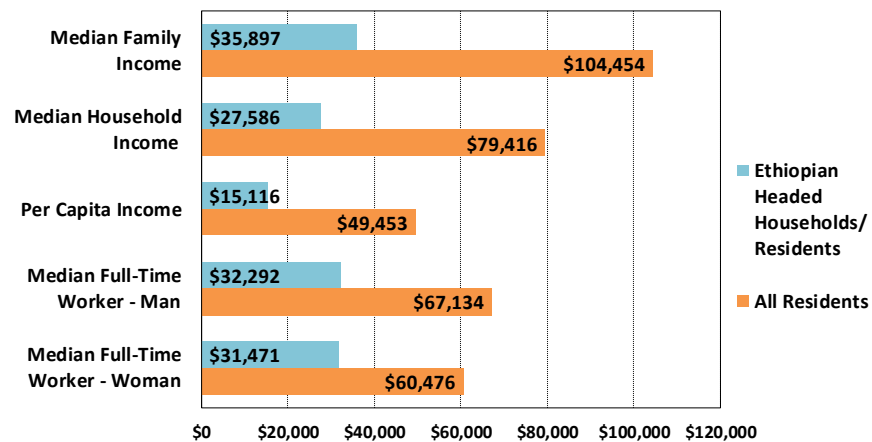
### Major Employers of Ethiopian Residents

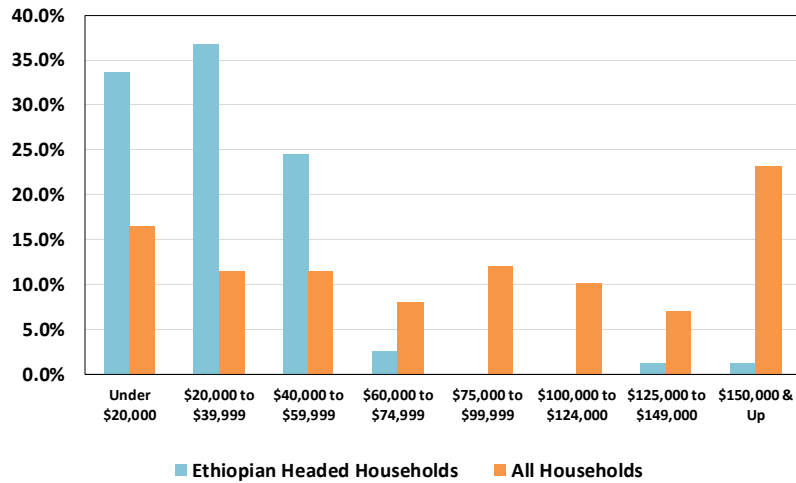
## Median and Per Capita Income: 2011 - 2015
