

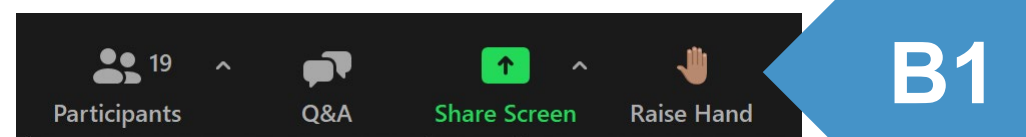
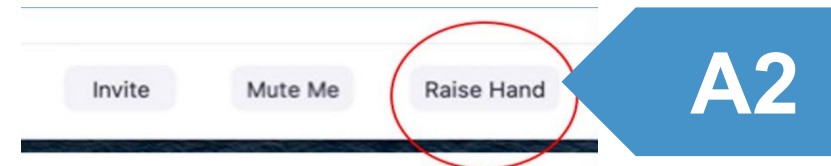
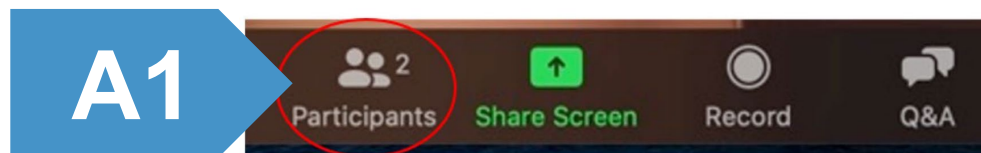
Before we start our meeting

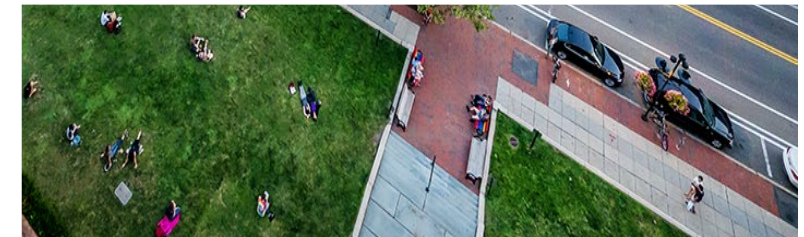
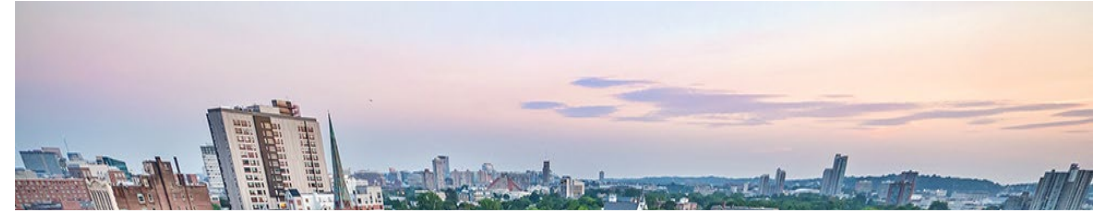
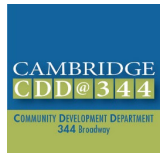
- We have 3 restrooms on this floor

DPW Updates

DPW Updates

On-going construction:

- **Harvard Square Kiosk Plaza**
 - Traffic management, Dunster Street closure for 4-6 weeks; and rerouting of #1 bus around Flagstaff Park
 - Committees to receive a project at a future meeting
- **River Street**
 - Street reconstruction on Fairmont Ave (shared street), and other nearby local streets
 - Fairmont Ave shared street should have raised crosswalks and final paving by end of this construction season
 - Carl Barron Plaza - work continues on demolition and reconstruction.
- **Binney Street Park**- is now open. Includes a section of Grand Junction Path between Binney Street and Broadway.
- **Chapter 90, Contract 24 –**
 - Huron Avenue – completing pavement markings and landscaping
 - Webster/Elm/Chestnut – curb and sidewalk work
- **Miscellaneous Street paving for October:**
 - Prospect St (Mass Ave to Harvard St)
 - Broadway (Portland to Columbia)
 - Cambridge (Second to Cardinal Medeiros)
 - Mass Ave (Sellers to Putnam)





DPW Updates

Upcoming projects:

- Mass Ave4 improvements:
 - The first construction will be median removal Linnaen – Waterhouse.
 - A public pre-construction meeting will be this winter – details and notices to follow
 - Continuing concept development for segments north of Linnaean to Alewife Brook Parkway – hope to have a public open house for Linnaean to Rindge later this fall or early winter.



TP&T Updates

Traffic, Parking, + Transportation Projects

These projects are managed by TPT staff

1. Cambridgepark Drive

- New separated bike lanes in the eastbound direction, filling in gaps in separation
- Installation begins **TONIGHT**

2. Main St (Ames St to Hayward St)

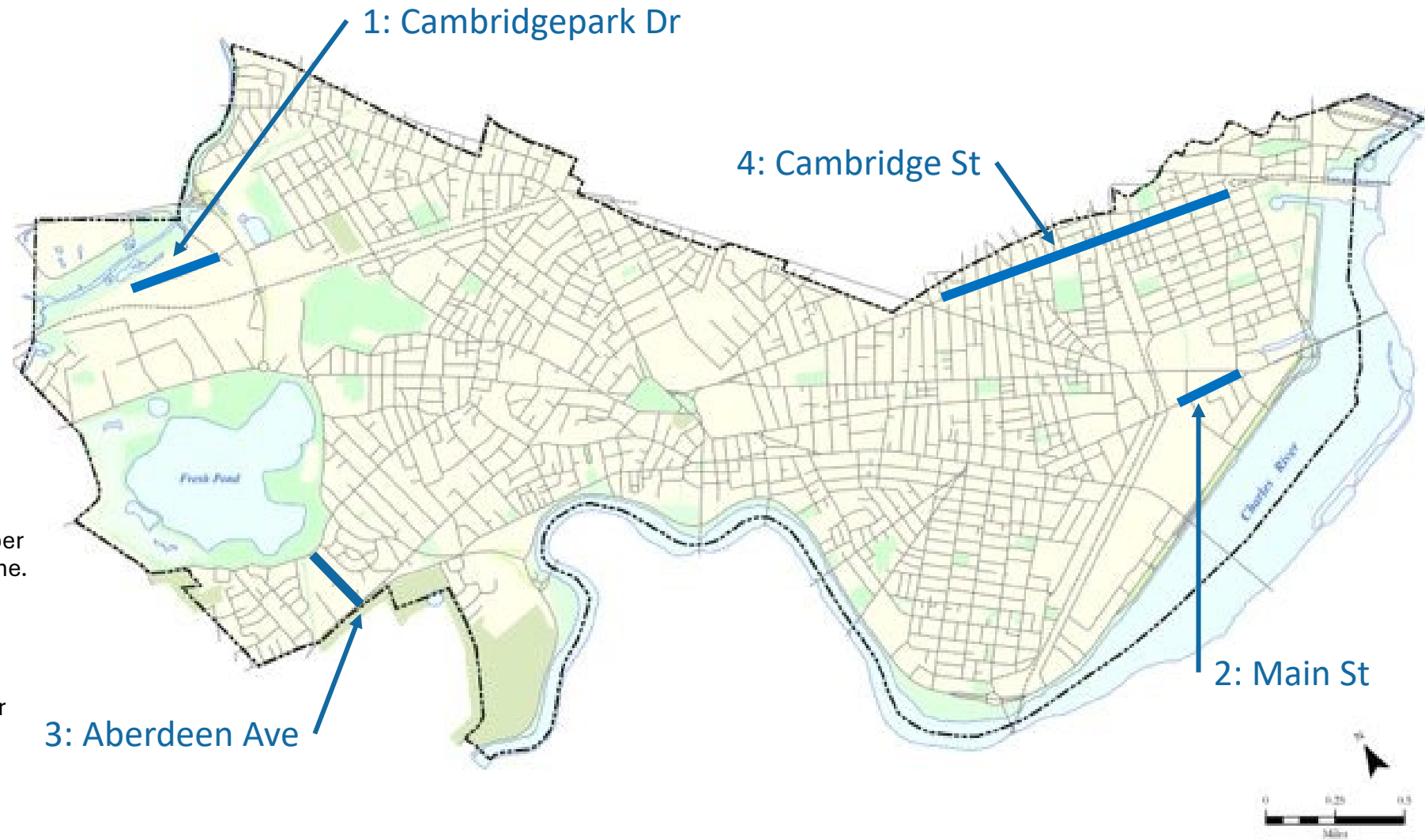
- Separated bike lanes for the Kendall Square MBTA block
- Project Open House took place last night, materials posted online
- Presentation at the Joint Transportation Committee Meeting was on September 18
- Installation in late October/November 2024

3. Aberdeen Ave

- Median-running separated bike lanes
- Community meeting took place on September 24 at 6 p.m. via Zoom. Materials posted online.
- Installation in Spring 2025

4. Cambridge St (Oak St to Second St)

- Forming Working Group – applications under review
- Project has 3 sections w/ different timelines
- Data collection ongoing
- Maintenance paving from Cardinal Medeiros Ave to Second St this fall. Driving and biking lanes only. Markings to be replaced in-kind.

- Memorial Drive (Not a City of Cambridge project)
 - Cambridge officials shared a sense of urgency to implement short term safety measures
 - DCR shared that they are planning reconstruction of the area with traffic management work starting Oct 7.

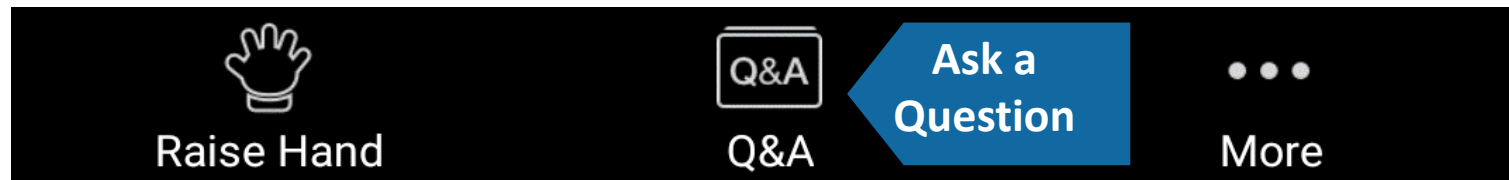
