If you do not have a Registry of Motor Vehicles ID, you will need to print your registration form and mail it to the Election Commission Office at 51 Inman St, Cambridge MA, 02139.

In-Person:

Cambridge Election Commission, 51 Inman Street, Cambridge, MA 02139 during regular office hours.

On Saturday, October 26th, you may register at any of the Early Voting Locations from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. or at the Election Commission office from 9 a.m. until 5 p.m.

The deadline to register or make changes to your name, address, or political party is Saturday, October 26th.

UNDERSTANDING EARLY VOTING



What is Early Voting?

Early Voting is an opportunity to vote before Election Day. You can vote in-person or by mail, and your ballot will be cast for you on Election Day. The early voting period is set by Massachusetts State Law.

Who can vote early?

Any registered voter in Cambridge can vote during the early voting period! Unlike absentee voting, you don't need an excuse or reason to vote early!

Where can I vote early in-person?

Unlike Election Day, you are not assigned to a polling location. You can go to any of the Cambridge Early Voting Locations detailed below. The Election Commission office located at 51 Inman Street will **NOT** be an early voting location for the Presidential Election.

When can I vote early in-person?

The Early Voting Period is from Saturday, October 19th, 2024 through Friday, November 1st. The times vary from day to day so check out the schedule below.

What if I want to vote on Election Day instead?

If you don't vote early, you can still vote at your assigned polling location on Election Day.

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT YOUR POLLING LOCATION MAY HAVE CHANGED.

You will receive a voter notification with your assigned location prior to Election Day, or you can look it up at www.cambridgema.gov/pollinglocations.

Polls will be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, November 5th, 2024. You can only vote once—if you cast an early voting ballot, you cannot vote on Election Day.

In-Person Early Voting Locations

The **Election Commission office** located at 51 Inman Street will **NOT** be an early voting location for the Presidential Election. Voters must go to one of the designated early voting locations listed above.



EARLY VOTING BY MAIL

Download an application from www. MailMvBallotMA.com or send a written request with your name, Cambridge address, address where you want the ballot sent, and your signature.

Track Your Ballot Online at TrackMyBallotMA.com

Send your signed application by email, fax, or mail. If you're emailing your application, you need to sign it in a way that can be compared to your hand-written signature. Electronic signatures, scanned applications, and photos of applications are acceptable. Typed signatures cannot be accepted.

Options for returning your ballot:

- Return the ballot by mail using the postage-paid envelope provided with your ballot.
- Return the sealed ballot envelope to an election official at a designated early voting location during prescribed early voting hours.
- Deliver your ballot to any one of the six (6) ballot drop boxes located in Cambridge. Drop box locations are listed on the last page of this guide.

Important Deadlines

Deadline to request a ballot: Tuesday, October 29th at 5 p.m. The Election Commission recommends applying as early as possible to ensure timely delivery.

Deadline to return ballot by dropbox or in-person:

Tuesday, November 5th at 8 p.m.

Ballots returned by mail must be postmarked by Election Day and received by the Election Commission office by Friday, November 8th at 5 p.m.
