ELECTION COMMISSION 24-HOUR OFFICIAL BALLOT DROP BOX LOCATIONS FOR THE SEPTEMBER 3, 2024, STATE PRIMARY

MAIN DROP BOX LOCATION

The following location will be open from Friday, August 9, 2024 to Election Day, Tuesday, September 3, 2024. **This drop box location will be the ONLY one open on Election Day, September 3, 2024.**

SATELLITE DROP BOX LOCATIONS

The following locations will be open from Friday, August 9, 2024 to Monday, September 2, 2024. **Satellite locations will NOT be open on Election Day, September 3, 2024.**

The Cambridge Election Commission is making it easy and convenient to vote according to your schedule. Vote early by mail or in person!

If you do not have a Registry of Motor Vehicles ID, you will need to print your registration form and mail it to the Election Commission Office at 51 Inman St, Cambridge MA, 02139.

In Person:

Cambridge Election Commission, 51 Inman Street, Cambridge, MA 02139 during regular office hours.

On Saturday, August 24th, you may register at any of the Early Voting Locations from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. or at the Election Commission office from 9 a.m. until 5 p.m.

UNDERSTANDING EARLY VOTING



What is Early Voting?

Early Voting is an opportunity to vote before Election Day. You can vote in person or by mail, and your ballot will be cast for you on Election Day. The early voting period is set by Massachusetts State Law.

Who can vote early?

Any registered voter in Cambridge can vote during the early voting period! Unlike absentee voting, you don't need an excuse or reason to vote early!

Where can I vote early?

Unlike Election Day, you are not assigned to a polling location. You can go to any of the Cambridge Early Voting Locations detailed below. **The Election Commission office** located at 51 Inman Street will NOT be an early voting location for the State Primary.

When can I vote early?

The Early Voting Period is from Saturday, August 24, 2024 through Friday, August 30, 2024. The times vary from day to day so check out the schedule below.

What if I want to vote on Election Day instead?

If you don't vote early, you can still vote at your assigned polling location on Election Day.

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT YOUR POLLING LOCATION MAY HAVE CHANGED.

You will receive a voter notification with your assigned location prior to Election Day, or you can look it up at www.cambridgema.gov/pollinglocations. Polls will be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, September 3, 2024. You can only vote once—if you cast an early voting ballot, you cannot vote on Election Day.

The **Election Commission office** located at 51 Inman Street **will NOT** be an early voting location for the Presidential Primary. Voters must go to one of the designated early voting locations listed above.

EARLY VOTING BY MAIL

Download an application from www.MailMyBallotMA.com or send a written request with your name, Cambridge address, address where you want the ballot sent, and your signature. **Unenrolled voters must also indicate which party ballot they would like.**

If you are registered in the Democratic or Republican party, you may vote only on that party's ballot. If you are unenrolled (commonly referred to as independent), you can choose a party ballot to vote in the primary and remain unenrolled.

Send your signed application by email, fax, or mail. If you're emailing your application, you need to sign it in a way that can be compared to your hand-written signature. Electronic signatures, scanned applications, and photos of applications are acceptable. Typed signatures cannot be accepted.

Options for returning your ballot:

- Return the ballot by mail using the postage-paid envelope provided with your ballot.
- Return the sealed ballot envelope to an election official at a designated early voting location during prescribed early voting hours.
- Deliver your ballot to any one of the six (6) ballot drop boxes located in Cambridge. Drop box locations are listed on the last page of this guide.

Important Deadlines

Deadline to request a ballot: Monday, August 26th at 5 p.m.
The Election Commission recommends applying as early as possible to ensure timely delivery.

Deadline to return the ballot: Tuesday, September 3rd at 8 p.m.
