



## Upcoming Traffic Changes on Broadway between Galileo Way and Ames Street

### Important Notice to All Road Users

As part of the ongoing MXD private development project and Eversource's Greater Cambridge Energy Project, Broadway will undergo significant traffic and pedestrian changes to support the construction project and establishment of the new substation. Please be advised that the contractor, Turner Construction, will make the following changes:

- **Traffic Changes:**

- **One-Way Vehicle Traffic:** Broadway between Galileo Way and Ames Street will be one-way only, heading eastbound toward Boston.
- **Two-Way Bicycle Traffic** will be established in a separated bicycle facility on the southern side of Broadway
- **Intersection Changes:** Signal and line striping modifications will be made at intersections to support the reconfigured roadway.
- **Transit Changes:** Impacted transit stops will be relocated for the duration of the change. Details to be posted at impacted stops.

- **Pedestrian Access:**

- Pedestrians will need to cross at **either Galileo Way or Ames Street** and may only walk on the **south side of Broadway** (opposite the construction site).

#### Implementation Timeline:

- Changes will **begin on Friday, 11/22** and are expected to be fully in place before the morning commute on **Monday, 11/25**.
- Preliminary construction work, including paving at specific locations, will take place in the weeks leading up to implementation to improve conditions for the detoured routes.

#### Expect Delays & Detours:

Significant closures and detours will be in place. Plan your travel accordingly.

These changes are expected to remain for at least one year.
