




Neighborhood park for "everyday" needs, as well as a venue for "big day" annual events.




ENHANCING & IMPROVING DESIGN, OPERATIONS, AND MANAGEMENT



INVENTORY AND ANALYSIS: ACTIVITY AREAS

- ATHLETIC FIELDS Targeted improvements to athletic fields
- PLAYGROUNDS All but Universal Design need renovations; they will generally be located in their existing spots
- WETLANDS AND TREES Impacts will be kept to an absolute
 minimum
- PUBLIC ART Renovate all

INVENTORY AND ANALYSIS: PARK AMENITIES

- SITE FURNISHINGS & FENCING Freshen up park amenities in existing or rethought locations based on the proposed improvements.
- **WALKWAYS** Resurface tired walks.
- PARK SIGNAGE Clarify where amenities are and how to get from here to there through fun signs.






INVENTORY AND ANALYSIS: CIRCULATION


- ACCESSIBILITY Incorporate and enhance ADA accessible routes
- **DESIRE LINES** Create direct connections for through traffic and consider addition of Fitchburg Crossing and New Street Multi-use Path
- MAJOR ROUTES AND
 ENTRANCES Strengthen major
 circulation routes and entrances
 through adjustments in width,
 accommodations for walkers, bikers
 and other modes of travel, etc.





WHAT WE HEARD: WHAT IS YOUR FAVORITE THING ABOUT DANEHY? (TOP 12)






individual engagements on favorite thing at Danehy (Pop-up events and Online Survey Combined)


