

A Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) occurred in the Little River/Alewife Brook and consisted of untreated sewage and waste.

Location: CAM401A: discharges upstream of the confluence of the Little River and Alewife Brook and upstream of the Route 2 Bridge.

Date: December 11, 2024 Start time: 2:37 pm End time: on-going Duration: TBD

Estimated volume*: 0.89 MG

*3-year average calculated using data from 2021, 2022 and 2023

Potentially affected areas: Arlington, Cambridge, Somerville, and Medford
