

Date: December 30, 2024 Start time: 8:27am End time: 8:37am Duration: 10 minutes Estimated volume*: 0.89 MG *3-year average calculated using data from 2021, 2022 and 2023

Potentially affected areas: Arlington, Cambridge, Somerville, and Medford
