This addendum is comprised of the following:

1. Question and Answer

The following question was asked and answered:

Question: Please clarify is the quantity 1000 inches of cutting or 1000 feet?

<u>Response:</u> The unit of measurement and the calculation is written in the contract; the unit is inchfeet and is calculated below through an example.

"Inch-feet shall be calculated by multiplying the average depth of the cut by the width of the cut.

Example: If a trip hazard is cut 1" on one side and tapered to 0" on the other' side of a full 4-foot width sidewalk, it shall be calculated as follows:

 $(1'' + 0'')/2 \times 4'$ 2 inch-feet

2 x price per inch foot = \$ total cost of trip hazard"

All other details remain the same.
