The following questions were asked and answered:

Question 1: Is there a set reservoir level that is to serve as the basis for exterior mortar joint repairs on the Gatehouse?

Answer: No. The Reservoir level fluctuates. Repair costs are based on unit quantities.

<u>Question 2</u>: Is the Cambridge Reservoir the City of Cambridge's primary reservoir? <u>Answer:</u> The Cambridge Reservoir is a supplemental supply source for most of the year; depending on rainfall it is often the primary supply in the summer.

<u>Question 3</u>: Can the Cambridge Water Department shut gates in the Gatehouse to eliminate flow through the downstream low-level outlet for the headwall/wingwall repairs? <u>Answer:</u> Yes, but depends on water demands and reservoir levels. One approach may be to shut flow for short periods of time during the day, while allowing releases at night.

<u>Question 4</u>: Any other launch areas to the Cambridge Reservoir? <u>Answer:</u> Yes, the Cambridge Water Department has another potential launch site off Old County Road in Waltham.



Question 5: Can Contractor store equipment in the launch area off Winter Street in Waltham?

Answer: Yes with erosion control in place.

Question 6: Please clarify which MBE forms are required with bid submittal. **Answer:** Instructions for MBE procedures can be found on page 00311-01.

All other details remain the same.

1. Project Objective:

- Hobbs Brook Gatehouse Uncontrolled leakage is currently entering the Gatehouse, as observed during previous dive video. Project goal is to repair/repoint mortar joints on the granite block structure both exterior and interior. This includes work by divers below Reservoir level (external of Gatehouse). Repair exterior anchors for stop log guides as needed. Following leakage repair inspect interior condition, with report. Include wet well, dry well, slide gates, masonry arch, etc.
 - Add Alternate 1 Repair arched outlet exiting dry well
 - Add Alternate 2 Repair dry well floor
- Hobbs Brook Low-Level Outlet Work Scour void is known beneath the headwall/wingwall. Project goal is to repair/stabilize the foundation of the headwall/wingwall structure, and restore the scoured area immediately adjacent and downstream of the culvert outlet. Work will occur in the wet
- **2. Observe:** Gatehouse and mob point; low-level outlet

3. Note:

- Cambridge Reservoir is the City of Cambridge drinking water supply; protect accordingly
- Waltham Policing will be required during mob/demob; Winter Street has work hour restrictions from 7-9AM and 4-6PM, during which no road closures may occur
- Waltham Conservation Commission issued an Order of Conditions for work at the lowlevel outlet
- Project is grant funded
