1. **Q:** When will the bid be awarded and how will we be notified of award?

A: Award information will be publicly available via tab sheet typically within 45 days of bid opening unless pursuant to Ch.30b § 5g

- 2. Q: Is there a conference call, zoom meeting, or in-person opportunity, etc., to listen to bid openings?
 - A: See bid documents.
- 3. **Q:** Are common carriers considered subcontractors?
 - A: Yes?
- 4. **Q:** Are there any bonds?
 - A: No.
- 5. **Q:** Are payments via Purchase cards required?
 - A: No.



- 6. **Q:** What are your terms and forms of payment (check, ACH, etc.)?
 - A: The Cities of Cambridge and Newton both use Checks/ACH
- 7. **Q:** Please provide an example of a BOL and invoice.
 - **A:** Invoicing will come from the awarded vendor to the Cities.
- 8. **Q:** Who was previously awarded the bid?
 - A: Broco Oil
- 9. **Q:** Please provide prior bid tabs.

- 10. **Q:** Is this a fixed cost through the duration of the contract?
 - **A:** Please refer to the price proposal section in the bid documents.
- 11. **Q:** What is the monthly volume per product type?
 - **A:** Monthly volume may fluctuate, see annual estimates in the bid specifications for expected usage. Estimated monthly volume for the City of Cambridge is:

Cambridge DPW est. 4,500gal every 2 weeks

Cambridge Fire Department est. 2,500gal every month

- 12. **Q:** What is the average order size of each product type?
 - A: For the City of Newton: 5,000gal. Please see above for City of Cambridge estimates
- 13. **Q:** Which locations require a tank wagon or transport truck?
 - **A:** Neither locations listed for the City of Newton require tank wagons or transport trucks. All locations for City of Cambridge require transport truck only.
- 14. Q: Which locations have above ground and below ground tank? Are truck pumps required?
 - **A:** Both locations listed for the City of Newton are above-ground. Yes, pumps are required. City of Cambridge locations are below ground, and truck pumps are not required.
